Twelve thousand posters are being used to blanket the subways, busses, and trolley cars in a campaign to promote the ice and roller skating facilities at Flushing Meadow Park. The city's golf courses, tennis courts and swimming pools are also publicized in a series of posters which will be distributed shortly by the Park Department.
